► CHINESE COURSE OUTCOME

1. After Successful completion of this course students will be acquire Foundational Chinese Language Skills:

- Learning best of China's history, geography, economy, and culture
- Master essential greetings and phrases in Chinese
- Acquire introductory knowledge of the Chinese language, including script, dialects, and tonal aspects
- Develop proficiency in reading and writing Pinyin for accurate pronunciation
- Learn to write basic Chinese characters and strokes
- Familiarity with Chinese numbers, dates, and expressions
- Enhance conversational skills for self-introduction and everyday interactions
- Focus on tangibles like employment

2. To what extent will the students be able to understand/communicate in that language?

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- Engage in basic conversations, greetings, and expressions in Chinese
- Read and pronounce words in Pinyin accurately
- Write basic Chinese characters and words in Pinyin
- Understand and use numbers, dates, and mobile numbers in Chinese contexts
- Introduce themselves and inquire about others' names, ages, and nationalities

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3. After the completion, the students will be equipped with what skills?

- **Language Proficiency:** Students will acquire a foundational proficiency in the Chinese language, including basic conversational skills, pronunciation, and vocabulary
- **Cultural Awareness:** Understanding of essential aspects of Chinese history, culture, and societal norms, enhancing cross-cultural communication
- **Basic Writing Skills:** Introduction to writing in Pinyin and basic Chinese characters, laying the groundwork for further language development
- **Numeracy in Chinese:** Competency in using numbers, dates, and mobile numbers in Chinese
- **Self-Introduction Skills:** Ability to introduce themselves, ask questions about names and ages, and express nationality
- **Cultural Appreciation:** Beyond language skills, students will gain an appreciation for import, export, and trade business ideas about China, enabling them to navigate social interactions in a culturally sensitive manner
- **Linguistic Confidence:** Students will develop confidence in their ability to communicate in Chinese, setting a solid foundation for further language exploration
- **Preparation for Further Study:** The course serves as a stepping stone for students interested in pursuing advanced Chinese language studies, providing them with essential linguistic tools to apply for Chinese language second credit course



► COURSE OUTLINE

- A full introduction course in Mandarin. Throughout the course, students will learn about basic day-to-day interactions, simple situational dialogues, basic vocabulary, and an introduction to pictorial script.
- No prior knowledge or language skills are required. Admission is open to anyone above the age of 18 and with an HSC or comparable educational background.
- Language study materials will be distributed to each student online. Access to an online question bank.
- Students must obtain a minimum of 50% grades. Questions will be based on 15 hours of teaching and a question bank. Formative, objective, and subjective questions will be asked during the exam.

► ASSESSMENT AND GRADING

- Graded and non-graded assessments will be used in the course for formative and summative assessment.

1. Graded Assessment: Total 100 marks (25 Marks for one credit) **08 Quizzes** with 5 items and five marks each ($8*5=40$) **4 Assignments** with 5 marks each ($4*5=20$). **Course end exam** with 40 objective types questions one mark for each question ($40*1=40$)

2. Non-graded assessment: Discussion forums, Case studies, Group work, practice activities, etc.

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➤ CERTIFICATION

- **Successful Completion Recognition:** Upon successfully completing the language course and achieving the required grades in the examination, students will be acknowledged for their dedication and achievement.
- Students who meet the following criteria will receive a Course Completion Certificate, with credit.
 1. Active participation in at least 70% of non-graded course activities.
 2. Earning a minimum of 50% marks in both the graded formative and summative assessments separately.

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

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
