## **FRENCH COURSE OUTCOME**

### **1. What will students learn?**

#### **Introduction to French Language:**

- Gain insights into France as a country, including geography, national symbols, and culture.
- Explore the similarities and differences between French and Indian culture.
- Understand the career prospects associated with learning the French language.

#### **Basic of French Language:**

- Master the French alphabets, and phonetics.
- Acquire the ability to pronounce and differentiate French sounds through revision.

#### **Genders, Singular-Plural, and Articles in French:**

- Understand the concept of gender (masculine and feminine) in French.
- Learn to write feminine nouns corresponding to given masculine nouns.
- Grasp the usage of indefinite (un, une, des) and definite (le, la, l', les) articles.
- Discover how to make singular nouns plural, including exceptions in French grammar.

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### **Introduction to French Vocabulary:**

- Expand vocabulary in areas such as colors, days of the week, months, and basic greetings.
- Learn vocabulary related to fruits, vegetables, nations, nationalities, the house, numbers (1 to 1000), and time.
- Explore vocabulary related to the body, clothing, and the geography of France.

### **Basics of Talking to French People and Speaking in French:**

- Develop the ability to introduce oneself in French.
- Understand the nuances of politeness in French speech.
- Learn essential phrases for asking for directions and engaging in basic conversations.

### **Film Screening:**

- Watch and discuss the film "Le Ballon Rouge" to enhance listening and comprehension skills.

### **Prepositions, Formal and Informal Communication in French:**

- Master the usage of prepositions in French.
- Understand formal and informal communication, including the use of "vous" and "tu."

### **Introduction to Verbs in French and Negation:**

- Explore negation in French using "C'est" and "Ce sont."
- Learn subject pronouns and the introduction to regular and irregular verbs (er, ir, re endings).
- Focus on the verb "être" and "avoir," including negation and interrogation.

### **Introduction to Verbs in French and Negation (Il y a):**

- Conjugate verbs ending with "er" and understand their meanings.
- Explore the use of "Il y a" in negation and interrogation.



## **2. After the completion, the students will be equipped with what skills?**

### **Language Proficiency:**

- Hold basic conversations in French, including self-introduction and asking for directions.
- Read and understand written French texts.
- Write simple sentences in French, including the correct usage of articles, genders, and plurals.

### **Cultural Awareness:**

- Develop an appreciation for French culture and customs.

## **3. Till what extent will the students be able to understand/communicate in that language?**

### **Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:**

- Engage in basic conversations in French, covering personal details, greetings, and directions.
- Read and comprehend simple texts in French.
- Write basic sentences, demonstrating an understanding of French grammar rules.





## COURSE OUTLINE

- A full introduction course in French. Throughout the course, students will learn about basic day-to-day interactions, simple situational dialogues, basic vocabulary, and an introduction to pictorial script.
- No prior knowledge or language skills are required. Admission is open to anyone above the age of 18 and with an HSC or comparable educational background.
- Language study materials will be distributed to each student online. Access to an online question bank.
- Students must obtain a minimum of 50% grades. Questions will be based on 15 hours of teaching and a question bank. Formative, objective, and subjective questions will be asked during the exam.



## ASSESSMENT AND GRADING

- Graded and non-graded assessments will be used in the course for formative and summative assessment.
1. **Graded Assessment:** Total 100 marks (25 Marks for one credit) **08 Quizzes** with 5 items and five marks each ( $8 \times 5 = 40$ ) **4 Assignments** with 5 marks each ( $4 \times 5 = 20$ ). **Course end exam** with 40 objective types questions one mark for each question ( $40 \times 1 = 40$ )
  2. **Non-graded assessment:** Discussion forums, Case studies, Group work, practice activities, etc.

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## CERTIFICATION

- **Successful Completion Recognition:** Upon successfully completing the language course and achieving the required grades in the examination, students will be acknowledged for their dedication and achievement.
- Students who meet the following criteria will receive a Course Completion Certificate, with credit.
  1. Active participation in at least 70% of non-graded course activities.
  2. Earning a minimum of 50% marks in both the graded formative and summative assessments separately.

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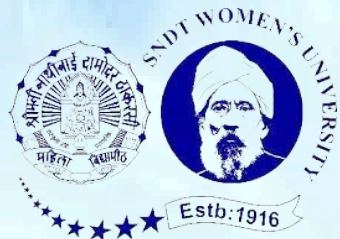
## COURSE FEES
